ON THE POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCHER POSITIONS

With the aim of implementing the target project No. 1.5. "System of Postdoctoral Research Positions" of the strategic direction "Innovative Research" of the Strategic Plan of Vilnius University 2015-2017, approved by Resolution of the Council of Vilnius University No. T-2016-2-4 of 3 February 2016 "On the Approval of the Strategic Plan of Vilnius University 2015-2017" and attracting more young talents to the University to conduct research, as well as to more effectively integrate into the global researcher mobility network, taking into account Resolution of the Research Affairs Committee of the Senate of 28 June 2016 (Minutes No. MK-2015/2016-11), and in accordance with Articles 15(1), 15(8), 17, and 33(1)(12) of the Statute of Vilnius University (hereinafter the 'Statute'),
the Senate of Vilnius University

hereby d e c i d e s:

1. To approve a new researcher position at Vilnius University – postdoctoral researcher, which corresponds to the position of a postdoctoral fellowship holder established in Article 66 of the Republic of Lithuania Law on Higher Education and Research approved by Resolution of the Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania No. XII-2534 of 29 June 2016 and Article 17 of the Statute.
2. To assign the Rector to approve, by 31 March 2017, the Temporary Description of the Procedure for Postdoctoral Fellowships at Vilnius University, corresponding to the requirements set out in Article 66 of the Law on Higher Education and Research, until the Regulatory Framework for Research, Artistic Activity and Studies of Vilnius University is approved.
3. To authorise the Research Affairs Committee of the Senate to participate in the implementation of the Temporary Description of the Procedure for Postdoctoral Fellowships at Vilnius University and submit it for consideration to the Senate.
